### **Collegedale**

#### Objectives

1. Improve flow capacity at the Wolftever Creek/Tallant Road bridge.
2. Reduce flooding on Apison Pike at Wolftever Creek.

#### **Preferred Actions**

- 1. Routinely clean debris from support bracings under bridges.*

**Responsible Agency:** Public Works – (Rodney Keeton – Public Works Director)

**Priority:** High

**Cost Estimate:** Existing Staff

**Benefit:** Reduce backup flooding on Apison Pike and Tallant Road

**Potential funding source:** Existing budget

**Schedule:** Continuous

- 2. Raise State Route 317 at McKee Plant #2 to alleviate roadway flooding.*

**Responsible Agency:** TDOT – (Wesley Hughen – TDOT Region II Project Manager)

**Priority:** Medium

**Cost Estimate:** Based on feasibility study

**Benefit:** Eliminate chronic flooding problem on State Route 317

**Potential funding source:** TDOT

**Schedule:** Project completion date = 2015
