

COLLEGEDALE IS...

STRATEGICALLY CONNECTED TO THE REGION

Collegedale is situated in eastern Hamilton County fifteen minutes east of downtown Chattanooga along the Interstate 75 corridor. The city's location affords easy access to Chattanooga, Cleveland, North Georgia, the Chattanooga Metropolitan Airport, Volkswagen of America, Amazon.com and other major employers. The city also enjoys freight rail service and is located within twenty minutes of two Tennessee River port terminals.

HIGHWAYS

Interstate 75

One of the major north-south interstates in the East, I-75 provides easy access to Atlanta, Knoxville, Tampa, Cincinnati, Detroit and other markets.

Interstate 24

Located just west of Collegedale, I-24 provides access to Nashville, and major Midwestern cities such as Chicago and St. Louis by connecting with I-65 or I-57.

Interstate 59

I-59 is accessed just west of Chattanooga and allows access to Birmingham and New Orleans. In addition, I-59 connects with I-65 in Birmingham to provide easy access to Mobile, Alabama-a major port city on the Gulf Coast.

FREIGHT RAIL

Collegedale is served by Norfolk Southern Corporation and is part of the largest consolidated rail system in the U.S.

AIRPORTS

Collegedale Municipal Airport (KFGU)

Owned by the City of Collegedale, the Collegedale Municipal Airport offers a runway length of 5,003 feet that accommodates a wide range of corporate and general aviation needs. Around 120 aircraft are based at the airport.

Chattanooga Metropolitan Airport (KCHA)

Located 15 minutes away, the Chattanooga Metropolitan Airport provides facilities for regularly scheduled passenger service, commercial air cargo, corporate and general aviation users.

Collegedale is a “destination of choice” because of its favorable location in a key growth corridor as well as the amenities it provides its residents and business owners. Between 2000 and 2010, the City’s population grew 27%-making it the fastest-growing municipality in Hamilton County. Most of the City is located within 10 minutes of the Enterprise South Industrial Park which is an industrial megasite hosting Volkswagen of America’s newest North American assembly plant and a major Amazon.com distribution center.

Collegedale is also the home of one of Hamilton County’s largest employers-McKee Foods, maker of Little Debbie Snack Cakes. The City is also home to Southern Adventist University which has an enrollment of over 3,000 students. The City is adjacent to the Summit of Softball Complex which hosts large tournaments through the year.
